## Re: Highway works on Bradford Road and Fox Hill

As part of the development of Mulberry Park, Curo is carrying out highways improvements to Bradford Road and Fox Hill on behalf of Bath & North East Somerset Council.

These works will create a safer junction for all road users by widening Fox Hill at the junction with Bradford Road and creating a right-hand turning lane out of Fox Hill. They will also create a new roundabout on Bradford Road at the entrance to Mulberry Park (opposite Greendown Terrace).

Curo aims to be a considerate neighbour and as a matter of courtesy we are writing to let you know that we will be starting this work shortly.

## 1. Timescales

Highway improvement work is programmed to start in the week of Monday 18 July 2016. Work will be carried out at the junction of Bradford Road and Fox Hill. When this is completed, work to the new roundabout will take place.

Work will continue for approximately 14 weeks.

Work will be carried out within the hours of 7.30am and 6.00pm.

## 2. Traffic management

To ensure that these works are carried out safely, restrictions will be put in place at the junction of Bradford Road and Fox Hill. These restrictions will include:

 4-way temporary traffic lights to control traffic from Bradford Road, Fox Hill and Cleevedale Road;

- Suspension of on-street parking close to the affected junction on Bradford Road, Fox Hill and Cleevedale Road;
- Suspension of the bus stop opposite Foxhill House, serving routes heading west along Bradford Road. While this bus stop is out of service, the nearest alternative bus stop is opposite Bradford Road shops.

During works to build the new roundabout, restrictions will include:

- 3-way temporary traffic lights to control traffic from Bradford Road and Greendown Place;
- The suspension of on-street parking close to the affected junction on Bradford Road.
